Age groups: OOTB has various camps serving ages 4 thru 18 -some camps will read “elementary/ middle school) this means we will have TWO camps going on at the same time. The students will be separated by age. All others will list ages. Pre-school camps do not have other ages with them.

“WILD ABOUT THE WHEEL” BEGINNERS: GET MESSY! This is a great experience on the Potter’s wheel for beginners. Campers will learn the basics of centering, “ throwing” vessels, adding handles and other attachments, as well as embellishments with textures, scraffito , trimming, use of tools, glazes and firing techniques Some of the projects include bird house/ toad houses/ cups/ friendship pots/mugs/upside down pots..Projects are not repeated so you may attend more than one week. “WILD ABOUT THE WHEEL” JUST For Tweens AND Teens! This is for the older student who may or may not have had some experience on the wheel. We will be teaching the next level up!!! BIGGER and Better vessels, altered vessels, adding hand built pieces with great imagination. Camps will be encouraged to make functional pieces such as bowls, plates, pitchers, mugs, garden pieces, wafer bowls, and so much more. Based on the experience of the camp/ return campers etc the teacher has projects designed for all! If you repeat the camp during the summer you will do different projects!

This is not beginner. This is for the student that has been to camp or classes and wants to Stretch farther with new ideas, tools and glazes.

Using Pinch, slab and coil in hand building. Throwing, centering on the wheel to master vessels, tools and glazes! How does a kiln work, what is “slip”, what is a mold? What is a “rib”? OOTB has joined with our friends the Estes of the “mobile science lab” this is a great way for campers to have both worlds of fun! They will spend 1 hour or so on the mobile lab right outside our doors at OOTB creating a science project then will come back in to enjoy related art projects! This is just too great. Limit 15 students.

Animals, Animals, Animals..... campers will enjoy a different animal each day while they make projects such as: **Ancients** animals: observe real fossils; assemble dinosaur skeleton, cast fossils, Ocean day: make a hydrometer, take home micro shells and ocean organism. Creepy crawler day: Observe insects, mount a grasshopper, and make a slide of insect wings, Hot Rock day: Animals: discover why animals need a hot rock to start their day! Make a simulated dragon fly wing and show how it heats up! Pond day (5 day camps) discovers the pond system, study life cycle of frogs and fish make a habitat with a plant in test tube!

Art projects will focus on best loved books as well as compliment the science lab:

Some projects will be: **Ancients:** Clay Dinosaur/ Dino Tile/**Ocean:** fish Prints and paper mache fish, Sea animal diffusion, sparkle fish collage/ **Creepy Crawler:** Torn paper insect, butterfly painting, Collage/**Reptile Day:** Watercolor textured Turtle/Gecko watercolor and oil pastel/ **Pond day:** koi fish watercolor/ oil pastel/ Frog. Some of the Literature will be Eric Carle’s books on Animals as well as other classics! LIMIT 15 each camp.
