

## Programs designed with the Home school family in mind at

We have several programs that compliment the home school Curriculum... HOW are we DIFFERENT? We are not simply a studio holding a "home school class" by having it at 9:30 a.m.! We develop curriculum and classes based on the across the curriculum needs / world views of home school families!!! We understand what you are looking for because we ARE a home school family, having been in the home school community 15 years!!! We incorporate History, music, science, geography and Literature in various classes! ALL classes have an art exhibit every 8 weeks!



**Art thru the ages 101/ 102:** These classes are yearlong classes which run the same calendar as many home school hybrid schools .They approach Art education in a **chronological way**, studio art in clay, drawing, painting, collage, calligraphy, pen and ink, textiles, glazing, stain glass introduction... these are developed by age to teach the student how art relates though the time periods which they are studying, by **experiencing** it themselves! Famous masters' pieces, artist's lives and games/ slides used to reach all learning styles. A **new** style portfolio with art work and photos of art work will be used 2009/2010 year, sketch book, timeline( new ) and notebook, also developed. 101-K-2 class, elementary class. 102 are for older elementary and middle school ages that have not been through 101.Different projects for each level. Class maximum 15 ( 3 teachers)

**Art thru the ages 103: "Artists/techniques around the world"** this year long class approaches art and artists based on a **geographical approach**, assuming the student understands the time periods already. This is for the more advanced student who has had classes in clay, drawing, painting experience and wants to learn more about techniques, who is able to devote more time to each project. Create more challenging pieces. Some techniques will be color theory, printmaking, wire/ clay sculpture,mosaics,textile art,photographhy, collage, advanced drawing skills, large stain glass piece, painting. Development of a portfolio/ sketch book.( ages depends on skill level and past classes .1 ½ hours Class maximum 15( 3 teachers)

**High school programs:** These classes are currently held on Mondays./Thursday. The classes include Drawing, art appreciation and studio, potter's wheel, photography, and sculpture/hand building .We offer 3-4 each session. The students have some homework (reading) develop a portfolio along with their hands on art studio each week. The students receive high school credit for this at the end as well as a grade. 1 hour studio a week field trip opportunities as well.( This can be taken just 16 weeks for credit) Class maximum 10

**"Young Masters"** This is for the younger students. Studying different "block" of artists each 8 weeks. For example while studying the Impressionist they would create a painting of "Monet's Bridge". Students use masterpieces and lives of great artists to inspire their work at

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a young age! ( New projects of course for those returning) Ages k-2 1 and ½ hours Class maximum 10



“ Five in a row and more” and Before five in a row”

A **literature approach to art** based on classic books. Masterpieces are also incorporated. This year we will add not only FIR #3 but classics from Eric Carle, Dr. Seuss and The art Of Beatrix Potter. Ages 2-4( BFIR) and 5-8.(FIR)

A list of books will be given out at the beginning of class to enhance the class! Students learn to notice what type of medium the illustrators used by doing it **hands ON!!**. **Class maximum: BFIR: 10/ FIR 12**

“Art Sampler” This class has it all... it rotates **every 8 weeks** to a different art medium clay, wheel, drawing and painting. (It meets during Bristol science / Veritas math times as an elective.( Tuesday and Thursday) because this class is only 1 hour it is a very economical way to make sure your student’s art education is covered! Next year we will focus on American Artists/ Folk artist ages elementary and middle school ( class maximum 8 per class)

**NEW!!! “Portfolio-” An elements of art approach!!!** students design their own, each week they are inspired to create a piece based on a Masterpiece using all elements of art, building their own portfolio as the year progresses. Instructor: Amy Smith  
Ages 7-12( class maximum: 10)

**NEW!!!! CALLIGRAPHY and CELTIC ART :** This will focus on the developing and artistic way in which the wonderful writing in the Book of Kells and so many other art forms were produced through Calligraphy! Celtic art will also be incorporated. The students will keep a calligraphy book as well as artwork reflecting both Celtic art and calligraphy. Instructor: Jo Spillman (class max “ 12)

**NEW!!!! “ ART AND THE BIBLE”** A truly inspiring class! Looking at famous pieces of art work and artists inspired by the BIBLE!!! Students will discover for themselves as they create how the scriptures come to life in ART. Some projects will include Biblical pots formed both on the Potter’s wheel AND hand built, Stain glass window of “ The Life of Christ”, Jesus on the Cross in drawing, Resurrection piece in clay and textures, “The Last Supper” painting,/ Creating a Biblical painting in fresco and more! The techniques, styles and inspirations of the great artists will be explored! 2 classes levels:: elementary- tweens/ Older Tweens/ teens. Class max: 10

**OOTB sponsored Field trips:** we have approximately 15-20 opportunities for your student to enhance their classes with field trip/ studio experiences each year. We spend a great deal of time working with museums and art galleries in the area to research the best art experiences for our students. This will be limited this year to **ONLY OOTB students**. Most trips have a hands on studio element back at OOTB or at the trip destination! OOTB earns very little

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monetarily if at all from the trips while it take considerable amounts of time to arrange them, thus why we have to limit it beginning 2009/2010 to OOTB students as an enrichment ! We enjoy doing this for them!



These classes are specifically designed with the home school family in mind based on what they are studying .We offer many other workshops and 8 week classes that while all carry a art history element will not be as focused towards the home school curriculums. (Wheel, clay, drawing all levels, painting, collage, preschool classes, pen and ink, multi media etc)The classes follow a Christian world view of the arts.
