This is for students to enjoy talking many varied types of art.

HOME SCHOOL FAMILIES:

We are not simply a " home school class" just because we offer it at 9:30 A.m.!!! We KNOW the needs of home school parents to ENHANCE what they are doing in their curriculums by taking much more time to develop programs that compliment home school lessons!**We offer over 60 classes JUST for home school families!** Keeping art isolated is really not what it is all about... We tie art into history, geography, science and literature... while having FUN! These classes also help students build a closer relationship with one another and their teacher .In

many of the classes a syllabus is provided so you know what topic they are studying(new this year) We offer over 60 classes designed for home school families but ALL students can enjoy them, they are hands on!

In “Art thru the ages” classes a monthly newsletter with websites and handouts you might want to add to their folders etc they maybe developing at home(also new this year)fun art time lines will also be done in classes. Sketch books will be given in all ATA classes. Portfolios will be available to purchase for your students art work if you like. Art Jeopardy will be played as a fun review. Opportunities for workshops, field trips and related art information in the community will be given to your family!

Apprenticeships/Volunteering/ scholarships: OOTB is happy to have apprentices wanting to help in our studio that are current students here, or if a parent of student would like to volunteer in classes or administrative work to off set tuition we can have a limited number of these. We also need volunteers to assist us in community event such as festival, libraries, ministries, Adoption fundraisers etc that we provide for low cost or sometime no cost.College art majors? While our goal is never to turn away students because of financial need since OOTB is not non profit status we can only offer a limited amount of scholarships, but we are happy to consider your family.

SPECIAL TRAINING FOR OUR TEACHERS:

Our teachers have MONTHLY trainings to insure they are teaching in the “OOTB” way which includes games, visuals, looking at masterpieces,hands on studio project, a time students discuss in a positive way what they love about one another’s art work, what they enjoyed doing as well as what might have been challenging, classes are also given follow up ideas on local exhibits, festivals, web sites etc that might continue to spark the students love for the arts!Our teachers also attend offerings at High Museum, Micheal C. Our asst. teachers have been here several years, they are vital to our students and families. Student

We ask for one month notice/ tuition should you decide you need to leave a year long class since we have based salaries and supplies on the commitment.

We also offer sibling discount of 10% .(No other discounts please) **taking more than one class at a time????** The frequent OOTB class member receives **10% off the 2nd class** (just like a sibling discount)

1:45-2:45 Photography 101: VERITAS CLASSICAL SCHOOL : Middle school / High school basics of photography will focus on balance and white and digital photography. Explore with hands on assignments such as self portraits, portraits, landscapes, animals, still life and more. Students will have " critiques" to help one another improve, learning the importance of feedback to improve their work all the time. Students will create their own photo book. , camera (Need a digital camera Please)\$75.00 per month

1:45-2:45:Art Appreciation and Studio: AT VERITAS CLASSICAL: 1:45-2:45: Students will focus on the elements of art(no projects repeated from last year) while creating in a variety of painting(including unit on portrait drawing), drawing,(including classical drawing and composition)sculpture, clay, printmaking and design media.Students will learn art vocabulary while also creating in a hands on method(many of ATA 104 projects will be used as well). This can be taken middle school/ High school level for a grade. 65.00 a month.

12:00-1:00 PHOTO 103: Moving on up... have taken 101/102 or have experience? Come join this class as Adrienne challenges you! Students will be given weekly photo assignments, continue to work on photo journals, each will focus on a

different style of photography they love then develop that style! \$75.00 per month

2:30-3:30" Art around the World:" GREAT VALUE! STUDIO 8 weeks of each medium! Potters wheel, clay hand building, drawing and painting. Small class each class has only 8 students! Students will study ALL around the world. European art(painting),Drawing around the Globe, Clay hand building in Africa, Potter's wheel In American Folk art traditions./ limit 8 students **elementary**

3:45-4:45: Photography 102: Move to the next level if you have had 101 or a class this summer in Photography Learn how to use the DSLR camera. Depth given to camera settings, shutter speed, aperture, white balance,and more. Students will hand create their photo books, a joiner, and other projects.(note:(Sometimes we are asked if owners of a "point and shoot" camera can attend this class, this is a decision you must make. This class is designed for students with a DSLR camera. However, principles are the same for any camera. Point and shoot cameras do not have many of the features a DSLR camera has , therefore some of the instruction cannot be applied to these cameras..)

3:30-5:00 Art appreciation and studio(much like Art around the world for older students!)STUDIO This is for middle school and High school,. Drawing, painting, sculpture, and wheel all covered while elements of art and famous artists and their work incorporated. 16 weeks / grade available for home school students. 75.00 per month./ at OOTB See above description

TUESDAY: Open 10-5/

9:30-11:00 Art thru the ages 101: Students in ATA learn art in a chronological order. In this class they are hitting the highlights of time periods and famous artists! HANDS ON Projects will include but not limited to Color theory, Egyptian

scarab beetles, king Tut watercolors, cartouches, Greek vases, Roman coins, Early Christian Madonna and child painting, Rembrandt, Cathedrals, Impressionist Monet's Bridge painting on canvas, Van Gogh's Starry night, Modern periods Picasso, Matisse and this year in honor of the HMA exhibit a special Salvador Dali project they will love! We end with Pollock splattering and celebrating . Students use stain glass, watercolor, acrylics, pastels, clay, glazes, drawing and painting, and so much more! All students taught with visual reproductions, games, and focus on artist's lives. Elementary k-4 / 75.00 per month includes all supplies/ journal/ timeline etc

9:30-11:00 Art thru the ages 103: 3:45-5:15 Art thru the Ages 103:4th-8th

STUDIO.As students grow older they become able to spend more time on their projects. Like 101 includes games, visual reproductions, learning to look , critiques(in a positive way) They will do Egyptian Batiks, Canopic jars, Biblical Pots, Greek columns in clay, Roman sculpture, Early Christian Madonna and Child collage, Stain glass, Castles in watercolor, Bayeux tapestry, Impressionist artists in printmaking, Waterlillies,canvas painting and clay, Van Gogh's sunflower painting on canvas,

Cezanne still life and more. Multi media... collage, even a unit on the Potters' wheel! Includes time lines, sketch journals. All supplies.

This is for a student that wants to go beyond just 8 weeks they LOVE clay, wheel, hand building, paper clays, all forms of sculpture! Get ready to get messy!

3:30-5:30: "Meet the Masters painting studio": elementary/ middle school:

This is for the student that loves to draw and paint, be inspired by great masters! Each week a new skill will be focused on, over the course of the year the students will paint several works inspired by renaissance, impressionist, post impressionist, modern masters. One additional painting will be a "seasonal" painting., While students will be guided in technique there will always be room for individual expression. Students will be taught about use of major tools and techniques. Acrylic, water color as well as other forms of painting will be explored., OOTB does not use stencils, tracing on, or any other means other than teaching your child HOW TO DRAW AND PAINT. By working weekly on paintings they will continue to build skills over the year.. This will be two classes one for elementary and another for middle school in different class rooms., \$70.00 per month.

ONCE A MONTH WORK SHOPS/ Field trips: see "workshops tab" on our website. These are usually 3:30-5:30

Includes sci and art with the science mobile lab(Joe and Nell Estes), music and art, field trips with art experiences, seasonal workshops as well!

NOTE: we are currently offering year long science and art classes at Veritas classical school ONLY(we have 8 week versions in studio... both of these compliment Jeannie Fulbright Books wonderfully) See mobile offerings for details.

Registration and payments on Year long classes:

We offer several payment options for families to make art affordable to **ALL:**

1. You may pay **in full and receive a 10% discount which is like a free class!**

2. **You may pay monthly.** We have a registration fee of just \$30.00 one time if you decide to pay monthly. We will send you an invoice each month it will be for the same amount each time. (you may also do auto pay) Payments are due on the 1st of the month after the 5th there will be a late fee of 20.00. The way we decide the class fee is based on the total amount of the class then divided equally for your convenience. So there is a class fee due even if there are 3 week or 5 weeks in a month.

3. If you would like to pay monthly and have it **automatically deducted** we will be glad to do that on the first of the month also let us know when you register.

Please call or email us before registering so we may insure there is ample space in the class/ We will be happy to show you some of the samples

We base our staff as well as bulk supplies(to keep fees lower) on a YEAR LONG commitment to these classes.(we understand that job loss and moving can always come up) however ,otherwise we ask that you honor this commitment.

We cannot give refunds on year long classes.(we have already bought supplies and hired staff)

Simply print off the registration form from the website , mail it in or bring it by with payment . If you are a former student we can update your application , you may pay by phone with debit or credit.

We hope to have payments on line soon. However, we do enjoy the personal touch in talking with our families that has made our students and families so much like a family rather than a " customer".
